Horticulture and Maintenance:

We are making the Greenway more beautiful through attentive maintenance and important improvements in FY12.

The Conservancy uses organic and sustainable landscape practices to
both save costs and provide the healthiest possible environment for

park users. The Greenway is Boston's only organically maintained public

park and one of a handful of organically maintained urban parks in the
United States. Organic maintenance means no expenditures for chemicals,

and lower expenditures for watering. Plants are healthier, more

resilient, and better able to withstand the wear of public use. The

Conservancy's practice of not using herbicides and toxins also ensures

that run-off from the parks will not pollute Boston Harbor or harm the
delicate marine life. Children and pets can freely and safely play on
our park lawns without the worry of pesticides.

In FY12, we improved our organics program and our educational efforts for the public. We increased applications of our organic compost tea from 1,800 gallons in 2010 to 12,745 gallons in 2011. When a compost tea application is occurring, our staff now deploys new signs to educate the public. All of our vehicles are now equipped with "organic care" signs, and we did a limited roll-out of organic messaging on donated MBTA train car ads. Additionally, we added a new page on our website dedicated to our green efforts, including organic certifications, organic compost tea brewing, water resource management, green turf and weed management, and fuel efficiency.

We also made major horticultural improvements to two of the most visible areas on the Greenway. At Dewey Square Park, a grant-supported renovation of the western garden bed added 1,488 new plants for a pollinator garden, a raised edible garden & outdoor classroom, a rain garden, and an urban composting demonstration area. The rain garden, which was built in partnership with the Environmental Protection Agency and Youth Build Boston, processes storm water naturally. Food harvested from the edible garden is being donated to hunger-relief organization Lovin' Spoonfuls. Pre-consumer scraps from one of our food trucks on the plaza are being picked up for the demonstration compost bins. Our youth workforce development program is partnering closely with our horticulture staff on the maintenance of the garden space.

The Conservancy renovated the harborside planting bed at the Rings

Fountain, one of the most popular places on the Greenway. The plantings

there from the Central Artery/Tunnel Project design had not fared well,

with bare patches and diseased trees. The 1,500 new plants are already

bringing color, interest, and buffering from the traffic; additionally,

the plant mixture will be simpler to maintain. The design is by Pat

Cullina, who is nationally respected for his work at The High Line and

Brooklyn Botanical Garden.

The Horticulture staff also made numerous light touch throughout the park. This was the first full year of seasonal plant rotations in the 47 containers. We added 11,500 more bulbs.

Following the court decision about the Occupy Boston encampment on

Dewey Square Park, the Conservancy took quick action to restore the park to make it attractive, accessible and enjoyable by all. The entire area was re-graded to eliminate ruts and channels. Air spading addressed significant compaction in the soil, 60 cubic yards of organic compost and 50 cubic yards of loam were added. New sod was rolled out, dead trees removed and replaced with new trees, and improvements made to drainage and irrigation. Seasonal plantings and decorations were added.

In FY12 the Maintenance department's full-time and seasonal staff
responded to the daily and seasonal demands of running a clean, green,
and safe park. This means consistent, efficient and responsive work
practices, from emptying trashcans on a regular basis to fixing
problems promptly. Routine maintenance of all structures and equipment
includes environmentally safe products. The Conservancy's skilled and
dedicated Maintenance workforce includes individuals with disabilities
employed by WORK Inc. as well as the Boston teens and young adults from
the Conservancy's Green and Grow youth workforce development program.
And we welcome the help of volunteers, who provided 1,113 hours of
assistance in 2011; the program has grown each year and volunteers love
it-as evidenced by terrific feedback on the website Great Non-Profits.
There is an in-park presence 16 hours per day, 365 days per year.

Ongoing maintenance common to all districts of the Greenway included park electrical repairs such as light re-lamping and replacement of damaged or defective outlets, repairing and resealing of masonry pavement joints, graffiti removal and power washing of paved surfaces.

Snow removal and application of deicer occurred as needed in what

Some park features are showing age and wear and tear. In the North End Parks, the Maintenance department replaced both automatic backwash valves and coordinated final programming of one of the controllers that was replaced. Repairs were made to a stone wall damaged by a car. At Rings fountain in the Wharf district, all 120 Pico lights were meticulously refurbished. Nearly half were inoperable prior to this work and all but two were restored to full operation. Also at Rings, several shooter valves were rebuilt and the filter pump was replaced. The Chinatown fountain had a mechanical failure that resulted in the equipment room flooding. Damage was not as severe as expected and the fountain was back in operation following two and a half weeks of repairs. A new sump pump was installed in the Harbor Fog vault. Many Rings fountain pavers were reset in what has become a continual effort. Other tasks that were completed by the Maintenance staff during FY 12 include: additional skate deterrents were installed in the North End and Wharf District; benches were repainted and skate deterrents were welded to them; installation of 2 new area drains to prevent ice buildup in the winter and undermining of adjacent pavements; installation of fall-protection grates in fountain vault hatches; repair/reinforcement of 20+ signs; and regrading of all stone dust paths. <u>Public Activities - Programs and Art:</u>

The Conservancy has brought life, joy, and diversity of use into the park; from 2010 to 2011, patronage at park offerings increased 73%. The Greenway has hosted more free events every year: 201 in 2011 and nearly 300 expected in 2012. The rental carousel pilot drew nearly 100,000 paid riders in 2011, and usage of our free Wi-Fi network expanded to over 50,000 users.

Increasingly, the Conservancy hosts, rather than produces, events. We host programs like ReadBoston in the North End Parks; "Films at the Gate" in Chinatown Park; Race Amity Day; 9/11 Service Day with the Massachusetts Military Heroes Fund; the Boston Public Market

Association's farmers market; Greenway Open Market; FIGMENT participatory art festival; and the Summer on the Waterfront. We work with many diverse partners-North Bennett Street School in the North End, National Center for Race Amity, Chinatown Mainstreets, Sustainable Business Network, and many more. The Conservancy, across the water from the Innovation District, seeks to encourage progressive programming.

We supplement hosted events with select produced events. We bring life
and fun to the Greenway through the cold with our Winter Lights
installations and opening events, such as a community celebration for

Ice Chimes and a dance performance paired with Lighthouse at the Boston
Harbor Islands Pavilion. Our Greenway Mobile Food Fest brought food
trucks, carts, and bikes together with local bands, lawn games, and a
tasting contest - the winner was tempura fiddlehead ferns; the day was
profitable for the 21 small business owners.

This year the Greenway Mobile Eats Program expanded further and drew

national attention. The Seattle Times called the Greenway's trucks "some of the best in the country" and publications including Time Out New York and Travel+Leisure listed the program as a reason to visit Boston. Celebrity Chef Ming Tsai filmed an episode of his television show cooking on with multiple food vendors on the Greenway.

<u>Public art gives residents</u>, workers, and tourists a reason to visit, linger, and discuss. In FY12, funded entirely with private donations, we launched a public art planning process; this process has been shaped by nationally recognized experts, local art institutions such as the <u>Institute</u> for <u>Contemporary</u> Art and the MFA, and the best-attended community meetings the Conservancy has ever held. We deepened our partnership with the deCordova Sculpture Park and Museum, adding an audio tour to the Urban Garden installation on the Greenway.

The Greenway Gala is the Conservancy's annual fall fundraising event. In FY12, the Gala raised more money than in any previous year. Attended by 326 representatives from the business community, nonprofit community groups, corporations, foundations and individuals, the Gala provides the Conservancy an opportunity to say thank you to our supporters and provides a platform for sharing our current and future initiatives. Also, in FY12, a Board Development Committee was established for the first time.

Green & Grow is the Conservancy's workforce development program that

helps young Bostonians become effective and reliable employees through working and learning in an urban park. The 12-month program provides a pipeline to future studies/training or environmentally-focused jobs at the Conservancy or in the greater Boston community. It combines job readiness training with career exploration, environmental education, academic support, team-building, personal attention from mentors and attractive compensation.

This year we graduated our third class of Green & Grow apprentices, who worked in the parks with the Park Operations staff, where they made great advances in job readiness, learned presentation skills, and were introduced to ideas like land management and horticulture practices.

Highlights of their experience included on-the-job horticulture training and public presentations to other youth groups. In the summer, the Conservancy offers the 8-week Green and Grow internship program in which the participants gain on-the-job experience in both landscape maintenance and implementing programs and events for the public.

Since the beginning of the program, 100% of program graduates have

completed a successful transition by enrolling in higher education or

gaining full or part-time jobs with employers like the National Park

Service, Branching Out, MA Department of Conservation and Recreation,

### Planning and Design:

The Conservancy's P&D staff has spearheaded critical additions to the parks and is working on further improvements. P&D staff worked with the communities and our park operations staff to select the furniture and the signature umbrellas that now dot the Greenway. This effort continued with an installation in the plaza of Chinatown Park plaza that was marked by a community celebration.

P&D is project managing the exciting custom carousel project. The installation of a permanent carousel on Boston's Greenway will fulfill a long-held dream of the City of Boston and the community dating to the planning of the Greenway. The hand-carved creatures of this magical, whimsical carousel will be inspired by the wildlife of Boston harbor and the original Shawmut peninsula, as well as the imaginations of Boston's children. This will be New England's only custom-designed carousel and only accessible carousel, and is destined to become an iconic Boston landmark. P&D is managing the Massachusetts artist and carousel craftsman who is sculpting the characters, along with the nationally recognized carousel fabricators. P&D is also project managing the consultant team designing that landscape, ticket booth, railing, and winter enclosure. More information on the project and the presentations from the four community meetings can be found on our website.
