SUMMARY:

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The Rose Fitzgerald Kennedy Greenway Conservancy's program service

accomplishments lie in the operations and maintenance of the Greenway

(including planning for the parks' future), public programming of the

parks, and educational services. All combined, they support a ribbon of

contemporary urban parks that connects people and the city by providing

beauty, fun, and a sense of community in Boston.

Horticulture

The Conservancy is committed to operating and maintaining the Greenway in an environmentally responsible manner that minimizes our carbon footprint on the planet. We use "best practices" related to the most sustainable and organic methods known. We use efficient practices, eliminate the use of toxic chemicals, and build management methods such as composting that recycle important nutrients into the soil. Responsible land stewardship is central to our mission. Our best practices were proven effective during routine testing with our organic practices consultant in April. We observed healthy, stable soils with positive fertility. Compared with last year, Greenway soils in all but a few parks are remarkably stronger and healthier. Later in the season, plants held up well to an unusually hot early summer. Vermicomposting (also called vermiculture) is an integral part of the Greenway Conservancy's organic landscape management program and a vermiculture bin was created this year to collect worm castings and create compost tea.

Maintenance

It is the Conservancy's goal to ensure that the parks are clean, safe,

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and attractive for every neighbor and visitor using the parks. This

means consistent, efficient and responsive work practices, from

emptying trashcans on a regular basis to fixing problems promptly.

Routine maintenance of all structures and equipment includes

environmentally safe products. This year we successfully completed our

first full season of snow removal, protected the Greenway's most

complex fountain that had been damaged in the past with a multi-purpose

seating arrangement, remediated a major flood in an equipment room and

kept a popular fountain running during repairs, and installed skate

board deterrents.

The Horticulture and Maintenance department's full-time, part-time and seasonal staff responded to the daily and seasonal demands of running a clean, green and safe park.

Planning

Effective and creative project management, landscape design, and technical services are integrated into the future planning of the parks' maintenance, operations and programming. For example, we designed and installed the first cohesive system of park signage along the Greenway corridor during FY 2010. In addition, the Conservancy completed shade studies for each park resulting in the specification of tables, chairs and umbrellas for each of the four parks to offer refuge from the heat of the mid-summer sun.

We provided technical services and planning review to agencies and

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potential developers wishing to build in, or adjacent to, the parks.
This year we reviewed and commented upon proposed urban design
guidelines for new buildings adjacent to the Greenway (Boston
Redevelopment Authority Greenway District Zoning Study). A central
tenet of the guidelines is to protect the Greenway as the district
around it evolves making the parks an increasingly important asset in
the Commonwealth.

Operations, maintenance and planning all coordinated to review and facilitate two new facilities that will be added to the parks: The Harbor Islands Pavilion (a project by the National Park Service and the Harbor Island Alliance), and the Armenian Heritage Park (a project by the Armenian Heritage Foundation).

Form 990, Part III, Line 4b, Program Service Accomplishments:

Events and Programs

In establishing a broad range of programs along the perimeters of the

Greenway and in the Greenway parks, the Conservancy's focus is on

fitness, family fun and the arts. We are building on the existing

cultural richness of the City and engage multi-cultural and

multi-generational audiences with a range of activities produced in

large part through partnerships with local arts and educational

organizations.

Between July 2009 and June 2010 the Conservancy hosted over 150 free

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activities for a diverse audience in the categories of fun, healthy living, horticulture, culture and history. Fun activities included facilitated games; Family Game Night and Game On. Healthy Living activities included a Farmers Market, Fitness Walking, and Yoga and Tai Chi instruction. Horticulture activities included Horticulture Tours and History activities included a Walking Tour of the Greenway and Rose's Life, a tour chronicling Rose Fitzgerald Kennedy's life and legacy.

Other free activities designed specifically for children included Story Hour, Playmaking in the Park and Activity Carts.

This year the Conservancy increased attendance at the above-mentioned daily and weekly activities to 25,000. There is also a seasonal carousel (rented) that welcomed 77,000 riders in the 2009 season.

The Greenway was a setting for special events, including those produced by the Conservancy and those produced by outside "Third Parties". The best attended Third Party Event was a free Earth Day concert with two prominent bands that attracted a crowd of over 5,000 people.

In June, the Conservancy introduced distinctive and affordable and food vending to the parks with five mobile food carts and one food truck - a much-need amenity in the parks. This pilot program has been well-received by the general public.

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The Greenway Gala is the Conservancy's annual fall fundraising event.				
The Gala attracts over 300 people including representatives from the				
business community, nonprofit community groups, corporations,				
foundations and individuals. The Gala provides the Conservancy an				
opportunity to say thank you to our supporters and a platform to				
educate attendees about our successes, current initiatives, and future				
vision.

Educational Services

Green & Grow is the Conservancy's workforce development program that helps young Bostonians become effective and reliable employees through working and learning in an urban park. The 12 month program provides a pipeline to future studies/training or environmentally-focused jobs at the Conservancy or in the greater Boston community. It combines job readiness training with career exploration, environmental education, academic support, team-building, personal attention from mentors and attractive compensation.

This year we graduated our first class of Green & Grow interns & apprentices - 9 young people between the ages of seventeen and twenty representing 6 different Boston neighborhoods. In the 10-month apprenticeship program Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) are the centerpieces of the academic components of the program, and the

apprentices work in the parks as an integrated component of the Park

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Operations staff. Highlights of their experience included on-the-job horticulture training, an 8-week engineering curriculum, culminating in a bridge-building project, a transformative wilderness weekend, and public presentations to other youth groups. In the summer the Conservancy offers the 8-week Green and Grow internship program in which the participants gain on-the-job experience in both landscape maintenance and implementing programs and events for the public.

Graduates have already earned seasonal positions with the Greenway

Conservancy, while others earned full time employment or further job

training from the National Park Service or have gone on to college.

The Conservancy provides educational services in the form of content and curriculum support for grade school teachers wishing to use the Greenway to support STEM education. This year we partnered with a school in the North End neighborhood to help students become stewards of the Greenway and develop a Go Green Community Stewardship Day. The Conservancy education staff was on call this year to give guided tours of the Greenway for school and camps groups, often paying for their transportation to and from the parks.

A meeting is then set up with the independent accounting firm to review any questions that may have arisen. Once the audit committee and Conservancy approve the draft financial statement, the independent accountant provides an updated draft to the finance manager who then forwards on to the entire board of directors for final approval.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c: The Conservancy has board of directors sign the conflict of interest policy yearly. Disclosures are filed with the Conservancy Audit Committee which reviews and reports to the Board of Directors.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15a: The Conservancy Board's Executive Committee recommends compensation for the Executive Director. In FY09 the Executive Committee, at the direction of the Board of Directors, hired an independent consultant to conduct an executive compensation survey to develop a recommendation for any changes to the Executive Director's salary. The consultant reviewed nine comparable and relevant organizations either through direct surveys or the organizations' 990s and recommended a compensation package for the Executive Director based on these relevant organizations, performance and the economic climate. The Executive Committee reported the findings to the Board, which then voted to approve a compensation package for the Executive Director.
